Hello. This is the Gatehouse Awards Cadets Stage 3 Listening Examination.

Task 1. Listen and look at the pictures. Tick the correct box. There is an example.

Example: My house has two floors and a garage.

Can you see the tick? Now, you listen and tick the correct box.

(Repeat from here)

1. My favourite activity is having a picnic with my family.
2. The next train to London is leaving at quarter to ten.
3. My English language teacher is tall and has short blonde hair.
4. My brother is not well: he has stomach ache.
5. Tomorrow is going to be sunny with a bit of rain.

Now listen to Task 1 again. (Task 1 is repeated). This is the end of Task 1.

Task 2. Listen and look at the picture. Draw lines. There is an example.

MC: Look! This is the nice park near my house!
F: It looks big! Is that your family?
MC: Yes, we took this picture when my aunt and uncle came to visit last summer.
F: Is the woman holding the stick your auntie?
MC: Yes, that's my Aunt Kate.

Can you see the line? This is the example. Now you listen and draw lines.

(Repeat from here)

MC: Aunt Kate really loves animals, so she spent the whole time playing with our dog Max.

F: He's a nice little dog. It looks like somebody else in that picture likes animals too!

MC: Do you mean the little boy with number 5 on his t-shirt? That's my cousin Sam.

F: No, I meant the other little boy, the one looking at the ladybird.

MC: Oh, yes! That's Ben. He really likes to learn about new things. I think he's going to be a scientist!

F: Did he find any other interesting things to look at?

MC: Oh yes, there were bees and butterflies and even a frog!

F: So what about the little girl building something, the one next to the man?

MC: That's my little sister Alex. Uncle Tom is helping her build a house.

F: It looks like everybody had a great time in the park?

MC: Oh yes, we did!

Now listen to Task 2 again. (Task 2 is repeated). This is the end of Task 2.

Task 3. Listen and write on the lines. There is an example.

MC: Hi, have you heard about the school trip?

FC: No, I wasn't in school yesterday. What did the teacher say?

MC: the trip's going to be on Friday next week. We're all so excited!

Can you see the example answer? Now, you listen and write on the lines.

FC: Where are we going?

MC: We're going to the zoo!

FC: Oh, great. I love animals! Do you think we'll see a tiger?

MC: I think so. And probably lions, and elephants too.

FC: Wow! What time are we meeting?

MC: You need to arrive at school at 7 o'clock in the morning.

FC: 7 am? That's really early!

MC: I know, but the school bus is leaving at 7.30. The teacher said we must be on time.
FC: OK. Where are we meeting? Outside school?
MC: No, we should come to our classroom first.
FC: OK. Do we need to bring food?
MC: Yes, we need to bring our own sandwiches.
FC: What about money?
MC: No, we don't need any money. Our parents have already paid for the trip.
FC: I'm really excited! I hope the weather will be nice...
MC: I don't know, but Miss told us to bring a warm jacket, just in case...

Task 4. Listen and look at the pictures. Tick the correct box. There is an example.

Example: Where will Anna go at the weekend?

F: What would you like to do this weekend Anna?
FC: I don't have much homework to do. Could we go on a trip?
F: That's a nice idea. Where would you like to go?
FC: The weather is going to be sunny. How about the seaside?
F: I'd like that. We can get some ice cream at the beach.

1. What time did the library close?

MC: Excuse me, I'm looking for the school library?
F: It's on the first floor, but I don't think it's open now.
MC: Oh, but, it's only 3 o'clock?
F: I know, but it usually closes early on Mondays, at 2 o'clock.
MC: OK, thanks. I'll come back tomorrow.

2. What will Ted do in the afternoon?

F: Hi Ted, are you doing anything this afternoon?
M: I have a Maths exam tomorrow. I should study.
F: I'm going to the cinema to see a Spiderman film. Do you want to come?
M: I love Spiderman! What time does it start?
F: At four o'clock, but what about your exam?
M: I'll study in the evening!

3. How did Alex get to school?

FC: I'm sorry I'm late for class.
F: That's OK Alex. What happened?
FC: I missed the bus and I had to walk to school because my bike is broken.
F: Don't worry Alex, but try to be on time tomorrow. Now, sit down please.
FC: I will, Miss. Sorry.

4. What will Fred get for his birthday?

F: We need to get something special for Fred's birthday. Do you have any ideas?
MC: He likes cycling. Maybe we could buy him a new bike?
F: That's a good idea, but a bike is too expensive.
MC: How about a watch then? He hasn't got one.
F: Yes, that's a great idea! What colour should we choose?
MC: I'm sure he'd like a red one.

5. When will Tim see his friend?

F: What class have you got next Tim?
MC: Erm...I think it's Chemistry. No, wait a second, let me check. Chemistry is at 11 o'clock, so my next class is Geography. What about you?
FC: I've got Music next. So we don't have any classes together today. See you at lunch break?
MC: OK, great, see you then!
